Choose one of the poems to read through. Underline any examples of figurative language that you come across in the poems. Then you will create a poster to display what you find.

Your posters should include the following:

1. The title and author of the poem (the author for both poems will be Edgar Allen Poe)
2. Three examples of figurative language from that poem (Quote directly from the text!)
3. Three illustrations (that’s drawings!) of your figurative language examples.
4. A connection to a common Gothic theme (these are in your notes!). Write in a FULL SENTENCE!

For example: “This poem shows the common Gothic theme of isolation, because the man is alone in the castle.”
