## **Dark Romantics: Gothic Short Story Assignment**

#### Instructions

For this assignment, your job is to pretend you're a writer from the Gothic Romantic movement. For the next two class periods, you will write a short story that shows at least five of the ten comment elements of Gothic literature.

#### Common Traits of Gothic Romantic Stories:

- 1. Explores the darker side of human nature
- 2. Emphasis on emotions and imagination over logic/reason/science
- 3. Mystery and suspense
- 4. Setting/Nature as a character
- 5. Melodrama and sensationalism
- 6. Supernatural
- 7. The sublime (extreme terror)
- 8. The fallen hero (loss of innocence)
- 9. Isolation of the individual (physical and emotional)
- 10. Fatalism

I would like these stories to be at least one and a half to two pages in length. I am going to try to get computers for us to type them, but I can't make any promises!

Timeline: You will have two full class periods to write your stories: today and next class. These will be due at the end of the class period next class.

Note: Randomly throughout each period, I will be checking to ensure that you have made steady progress on your stories. These progress checks will be part of your final grade.
