

Planning our second Podcast

Recap from the last time we met: Just like writers do before starting an essay, podcast producers typically make an outline or plan before they start recording and editing. They brainstorm how they want to turn their topic into an audio story. What components will they need: spoken stories, interviews, narration?

Today we will be planning out our final podcast and possibly starting the script (if you have time!)





Outlines

Remember, these podcasts can be about anything, however, there should be a focus questions that drives the podcast. Fill out the planning sheet with the following information:

1. Focus Questions
2. Is there a narrator? What is her or his role?
3. Will you interview anyone? Who? (This will have to be done outside of class if you choose to add interviews)
4. Will the podcast include storytelling? What stories will be included?
5. Will the podcast include sound effects or music? Make a list.
6. What ideas do you have for the beginning and end of the podcast?
7. Make a rough outline of your podcast (this does not have to a detailed script, just a basic idea of what you are including and in what order).

If/When you finish...

If you finish your planning sheet, please run it by me before you move on. After finishing you should be working on one of two things:

1. Begin writing your final podcast script using the outline (we will have time the rest of the week to write them too!)
